

2. Participatory budgeting




If social reality changes, power relations have to change too.



# Phases of building a coop system


Cooperatives may include both, individual members (natural persons) and legal persons (institution, NGO)

3. Developing a cooperative system



"Protopia is a state that is better than today than yesterday, although it might be only a little better (→ small steps)" - Kevin Kelly




